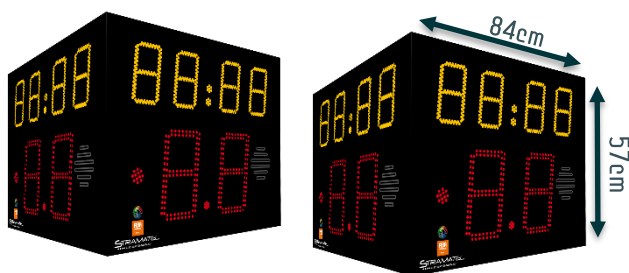
The ML3123-123 is used to display the score, the stopwatch or the time, the team fouls, the time-outs and the period. It also displays the names of teams and scrolling messages. The side modules display the fouls and the individual points of the players (12) as well as their name and bib number.

Shot clocks - SC24 TSP 4-sided

In order to be approved for FIBA Level 1, shot clocks must be 4-sided and repeat the game time. They have to be installed with red and yellow LED strips. The 4-sided SC24 TSP with its pair of LED strips perfectly match most of Basketball goals brands.

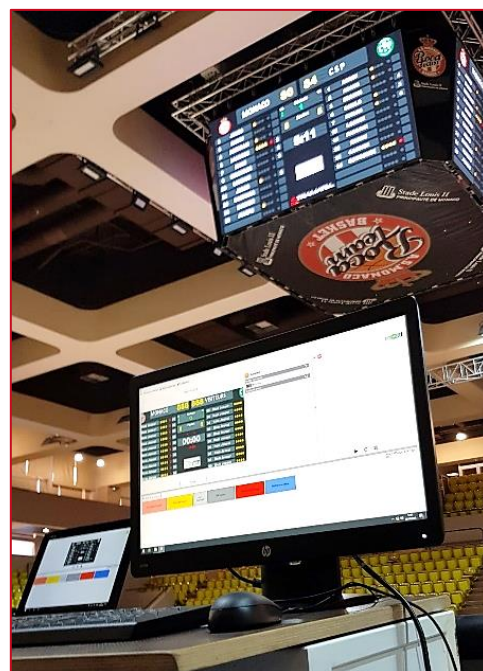
